## Putting It All Together Grades 2-3

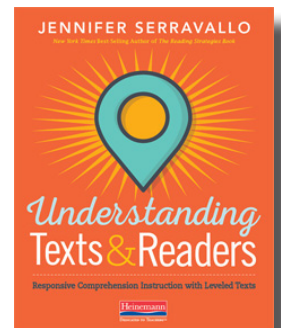
Critical thinking, assessments, text selection, conferring, reading strategies: How do we put it all together in a way to increase students' capacities as literate individuals?

- How to build students' deep understanding of reading through a range of instructional settings (read aloud, interactive reading, shared reading, guided reading, and independent reading).
- How to maximize learning by capitalizing on strong reading-writing connections.
